HISTORY: The GFWC-Beloit Junior Woman's Club established this award in 1999. It is a memorial to Robin Hebert, former member of the Beloit Junior Woman's Club. Robin Hebert was a Beloit educator. Her dedication to school, community, church and family activities will be remembered by many. Each year a graduating senior who demonstrates this same dedication to community volunteerism will be selected to receive this scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY: All graduating high school seniors pursuing a post-secondary education are eligible. Candidates must also demonstrate a continued commitment to school and community volunteer programs and activities.

AMOUNT: \$1000.00

DEADLINE: April 15, 2017

METHOD OF PAYMENT: This scholarship payment will be paid to the college of your choice upon receipt of your grade report demonstrating successful completion of your first semester. This scholarship is void if the recipient receives a "full ride" scholarship.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. A completed application with signature.
2. A brief essay (approximately 300 words) on either of the following:
 - a. In selecting your career/ educational goals, how have your volunteer efforts influenced your decision?
 - b. What "life lessons" have you learned by being part of a volunteer program or activity (e.g. compassion, leadership)
3. Two letters of recommendation from people involved with you in your volunteer activities.
4. A statement of your academic goals.
5. A listing of your community volunteer efforts while in high school, highlighting any leadership positions held (e.g. coordinator, officer, chairperson, etc.)
