The Clinton Community School District is grateful for the community's approval of a \$32 million investment to repair, improve and reconfigure our facilities. We're committed to keeping our stakeholders up-to-date about the progress of these projects.

FACILITIES VISION:

WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING:

- On July 7th, the Board of Education approved the 4K-6 building to be named Clinton Elementary School and the 7-12 building to be named Clinton Junior/Senior High School.
- Both Junior/Senior High School additions are excavated and the concrete foundations are nearing completion as show top right.
- Masonry walls on the Tech Ed addition started this week.
- Interior remodel demo is mostly complete.
- Existing 20,000 sqft wood gym floor has been demolished as shown bottom right.

WHAT'S NEXT:

- Structural steel starts at the end of July
- Concrete foundations will be complete.
