



Summer Credit Recovery & Course Completion FAQ

High School Summer School credit recovery will be offered in partnership with Rural Virtual Academy on a virtual platform. **Students must attend in person at CJSHS.**

Course Completion for Middle School Students will be offered during summer school to complete a course in which they earned a 0 or a 1 (No Evidence or Beginning). **Students must attend in person at CJSHS.**

Students and families will be notified by their school counselor if they are required to take a Course Completion Course.

What is Credit Recovery

Credit

recovery is a strategy that encourages at-risk students to re-take a previously failed course that is required for high school graduation. By completing the course requirements for a previously failed course, the student will earn credit for that course. All credit recovery courses are graded as a pass or fail. Credit will be earned with a passing score.

Credit Recovery courses have minimal pacing guidelines to complete the course content by the scheduled end date.

When is Summer School?

Session 1: Mondays-Thursdays June 16 - July 3, 2025

Session 2: Mondays-Thursdays July 7- July 24, 2025

Times for both sessions: 8:00 am - 11:30 am

How do I know what Credit Recovery Courses I need to enroll in?

Students and families will be notified by their school counselor if they are required to take a Course Completion Course.

For High School: Only required Math, Science, English, or Social Studies classes that were failed and cannot be made up in future years may be taken. You will receive a letter or communication from the school counselor if you are eligible to recover a course in summer school.

For Middle School, core classes in which a student has earned a 0 or a 1 as an overall grade will need to participate in course completion. You will receive a letter or communication from the school counselor if you are eligible to recover a course in summer school.

Teachers will determine which topics need to be covered and tailor credit recovery directly to student needs. In a case where a student has multiple courses to complete, administration will prioritize those courses.

When is the Deadline to Enroll in Summer Credit Recovery Courses?

Preferred enrollment deadline is Monday, June 9, 2025. Please note that there is a cap for the number of students enrolled in these courses and there may be a waiting list, so registering early is recommended.

It takes about four business days to enroll a student, so be sure to register early. Early registration will ensure the student is in the system before the start date of Summer School (Monday, June 16, 2025).

What are the Requirements once a Student is enrolled?

Students are required to keep up with the daily schedule. If **after four days** the student is not on pace, he/she will be dropped from the course.

Process/procedure for ENGAGEMENT/COMPLETION

2 days of not being on pace-- student contacted

3rd day of not being on pace--parent contacted
