



Notice of Educational Options

Clinton Community School District offers a variety of educational opportunities to children who reside in the district. The District's primary educational pathway and instructional program for students involves a progression from 4-year-old kindergarten through 12th grade, leading to a high school diploma. Some of the specific education programs offered to eligible students who are enrolled and attending the District's schools include, the following: Early childhood special education (for students who are at least 3 years old but not yet school-age), Clinton Connect, an online education option, Title I programming in reading and math, Special education for students with disabilities, Gifted and talented programming, English as a second language (ESL) programs, Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs, Work based learning options, Individualized program and curriculum modifications, Alternative education program(s), WI Challenge Academy, At-risk education (e.g., for students identified as being at-risk of not graduating from high school, and Summer school programming.
