On Tuesday, April 2, voters in the Clinton Community School District failed a facilities referendum by an unofficial vote 806 - Yes to 1166 - No. If passed, the \$41.9 million facilities referendum would have funded the construction of a new 4K-6 school building and addressed high priority capacity and maintenance needs at Clinton High School.

"We are disappointed the community did not support our facilities referendum, but we recognize the will of the voters. Clinton Community School District has significant facilities needs. As a district and community, we will need to decide how to adequately address the aging facilities. The district will continue to engage with district stakeholders to determine how to best meet these unresolved facilities needs," said CCSD District Administration Jim Brewer.

"Moving forward, we will continue to take time to listen to our community. We need additional guidance from the taxpayers we serve. Only then will we be able to determine next steps. Regardless of our future course of action, the school board remains committed to engaging our community in a conversation about our school district," added School Board President Ken Luety.

"On behalf of the district, I would like to thank the Board for its leadership, the multitude of community members for their time, expertise and energy, and CCSD staff for their dedication and commitment to our students," concluded Brewer.
