Enrollment: Enrollment is determined on a first-come first-served basis. **A class size of at least 12 will be required to hold a class.** Students enrolled in classes that do not meet the criteria will be enrolled in another class that best fits their schedule. It is understood that circumstances may force some courses to be canceled.

Transportation: Bus transportation will be available for ALL students that are attending summer school (in town and outside the village but in the district). If interested in bus transportation, complete and return the transportation request form which is available online. Bus transportation will be scheduled after enrollment. Parents will be notified of the bus schedule prior to the start of summer school. COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

7-12 Grade Opportunities

Strength & Conditioning

Grades 7-12

This class is designed for students that are interested in gaining greater strength, size, explosive power, speed, agility, and flexibility. The class is designed as 10 minutes for warm-up, 20 minutes in the weight room, 20 minutes in the gym or outside, and 5 minutes for a cool-down. Sign up for one of the four class times through Skyward Family Access. (Enrollment Cap of 24 students per class period)

Summer School Musical

Grades 7-12

The musical is for students entering grades 7 through 12 who are interested in performing on stage or helping backstage. The students will be involved in all aspects of the production; from acting, singing, dancing to painting, building, sound, costuming, publicity as well as concepts and principles of theater that are not currently instructed during the school year. The end product will be a production performance of *Disney's Moana Jr.* made available to the public. **This year's performance will be on Thursday, July 18 and Friday, July 19th at 6:00pm on the CES Stage!**

The musical will have OPTIONAL practices on July 1-3. Onsite breakfast and lunch will be provided, but **no** transportation provided for the musical students the week of July 1-3. (No enrollment cap)

Session 1: Wednesday, June 12 - 28

Outdoor Fun & Adventure (8:00-11:15)

Grades 1-6

Outdoor fun and adventure will be exploring a variety of outdoor activities through theme weeks. First up is "camouflage week," where students learn about different animals and how they survive. During "fishing week," students learn about a variety of fish and go on a fishing field trip to Kwaina's Pond. I wonder who will catch the biggest and most fish this summer? Lastly, "camping week," where students learn how to build shelters and campfires and take a field trip to Cavers Roehl Park to go hiking and hunt for crayfish. We hope to see you this summer! (Enrollment cap of 40)

Camp with Me!

Grades K-2

In this course, students will participate in camping related activities that will make them feel as if they are actually camping. Students will have the chance to explore nature and participate in STEM activities that challenge them to think critically, problem solve, engineer and construct, read, and use mathematics. Some of these came related STEM activities include making s'mores and ice cream, playing classic camp games, and so much more! Young campers, get ready to camp with me at Clinton Elementary! (Enrollment cap of 20)

Fun in the Sun

Grades K-2

Are you looking for ways to get exercise while having fun outside? This is the perfect class for you! Everyone will participate in warm ups, games and fitness activities to keep all students having fun and engaged. These activities will develop and improve your flexibility, cardiovascular endurance, muscular strength and power, and balance. Students will work together, learn about sportsmanship, and become problem solvers as well. If you are ready to have fun in the sun then this is the perfect class for you! (Enrollment cap of 20)

Let's Make Some Noise

Grades K-2

Let's explore handmade instruments, made by you! This course will allow students to explore the sounds that are made through different musical instruments. We will create and play all kinds of instruments made from recycled materials and built by the students. (Enrollment cap of 20)

Grades K-1

Outdoor Fun and Games

Grades 5-8

Students will be introduced to a number of team and lifetime sports and games. Students will work on basic skills through a variety of team and individual sports that will keep them active for their entire lives. Have fun, get great exercise, and learn about teamwork while exhibiting good sportsmanship. (Enrollment cap of 16)

At the end of Lit Camp, our campers will have strengthened their confidence and curiosity in reading. See you all around the campfire!

Getting Ready for 4K

All Periods: 8:00 - 11:15

The 4K summer school session is a 3 week introduction to the modified routines of 4K. During this 3 week time frame the goals include introducing essential 4K readiness skills including but not limited to learning routines, sharing, social skills, listening skills, and most importantly helping the

children adjust and be prepared for school when they start 4K in the fall. Activities include calendar time, literacy activities, math activities, singing, dancing, fingerplays, projects, free play, and gross motor outdoor activities.

Grade 5K: The ABC and 123 of Kindergarten!

All Periods: 8:00 - 11:15

Students will tame any fear of entering 5K through fun interactive readiness activities including math, reading, music, stories, and centers. (Enrollment cap of 25)

Digging Into First Grade

Grade 1

Students will prepare for the new school year learning all about dinosaurs! They will read about different species of dinosaurs, participate in a variety of STEM activities, and turn their classroom into a prehistoric forest! Help get your brain back on track and do it all while learning about these amazing creatures! (No enrollment cap)

ZOO-ming Into 2nd Grade

Grade 2

Students will learn about different groups of animals, their characteristics, and habitats. They will learn about animals through hands-on activities, projects, technology, readers theater plays, and reading and writing activities. Grade 3
