Enrollment: Enrollment is determined on a first come-first served basis. **A class size of at least 12 will be required to hold a class by April 20.** Students enrolled in classes that do not meet the criteria will be contacted to enroll in another class.

Transportation: Bus transportation will be available for students that are attending summer school who live outside the village but in the district. If interested in bus transportation, complete and return transportation request form (available online and in each school's office). Bus transportation will be scheduled after enrollment. Parents will be notified of the bus schedule prior to the start of summer school. If using bus transportation please complete your registration on or before the deadline to ensure transportation during the first week of summer school.

Cost: There are no fees for your child to participate in summer school unless specified by a teacher for a field trip or other expenses above and beyond classroom activities.

Food Service Program: During the upcoming summer school session Clinton Community School District will be offering a grab-n-go breakfast and lunch **at no charge** to all participating summer school students. Students will be required to eat their lunch at school; buses will leave at 12:15 p.m. to allow bus students time to eat. This free program is brought to you by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction and the USDA.

Registration: Main registration will be online again this year. Online registration will begin on **March 5th** and go through **April 20th**. Paper registration forms will be accepted **after online registration**.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Session 1: June 12- June 29

All Morning (8:00-11:55)

Grades 7-12: Summer School Musical - This is for students entering grades 7 through 12. The students will be involved in all aspects of the production; from acting, singing, dancing to painting, building, costuming, publicity as well as concepts and principles of theater that are not currently instructed during the school year. The end product will be a musical presentation made available to the public. The musical will run one week past the normal summer school session ending on July 6th. This year's musical is RODGERS AND HAMMERSTEIN'S CINDERELLA. There will be **no** transportation provided for the musical students that week (7/2-7/6). (No enrollment cap)

Period 1 (8:00 – 9:10)

Grades K-2: Storytime Activities Part 1- This class is all about popular children's books! Each day we will be reading a few different books and making a craft or doing a fun activity that goes along with the book theme. Children will also get a chance to act out scenes from the books and even get to dress up like their favorite storybook characters. Some examples may include reading books about a tea party and then having an impromptu tea party in the classroom or reading books about creatures under the sea and then making some of those creatures. Parents, students must also choose Part 2 of Storytime Activities (Enrollment cap of 16)

Grades 1-2: Chickens in the Classroom- Yup, you heard right, we will have baby chicks in our classroom! Students will get to witness the incubation, hatching, and growing of chickens. Throughout the course students will learn about different breeds of chickens. If you love baby chicks this is the class for you! (Enrollment cap of 14)

Grades 1-3: Camp Seussville- Welcome to Seussville, where we'll read our way into the wonderful world of Dr. Seuss. Wockets in Pockets and Truffula trees, this class will be a blast, and we think you'll agree! We'll meet Horton and Sneetches, Thing One and Thing Two! and of course the Cat in the Hat...Now all we need is You! We'll make art, puppets, and props as we get to know his crazy characters and classic rhymes - All while learning lessons about being a person, because a person's a person, no matter how small. (Enrollment Cap of 14)

Grades 1-3: Mad Fun Science- Fun hands on experiments will be conducted by our little scientists in the classroom lab. Art projects and cool concepts will be explored! Students will record their observations and predictions in their own science journals. Join us for some scientific adventures that are guaranteed to be explosively fun! (Enrollment cap of 16)

Grades 2-4: Let's Get Crafty-Do you like to make crafts? Or do you want to learn how to make crafts? Well, this is the class for you! In Let's Get Crafty, you will use your imagination and creative skills to make homemade crafts. Some crafts are BIG! Some crafts are small! Some crafts will be painted! Some crafts will be made from recyclables! If you're looking to spend your summer being active and artistic, then Let's Get Crafty is the class for you! (Enrollment cap of 14 students)

Grades 3-4: Conversational Mandarin Chinese for Beginners – Ni hau! Jen da? Shen ma? Hello. Really? What? YES!, A chance to learn simple, basic Mandarin phrases and write characters and learn a little Chinese culture! Come hang out and Shwo some Jung Wen! Come has some fun with Mrs. Lund! (Enrollment Cap of 14)

Grades 3-8: Disney Mania- Calling all Disney Lovers! This will be a class that is about all things Disney. We will create crafts, watch movies, and play games all with a common theme- Disney! (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 4-5: Sports - Students will be introduced to a number of Team and Lifetime Sports. The purpose is to expose the students to activities that will keep them active for their entire lives. The activities will include Rollerblading, Bowling, Racquet Sports (Badminton and Pickle Ball), Frisbee (Frisbee Golf), and a variety of team sports. (Enrollment cap of 30)

Grades 4-6: Nature Art- This course will involve using materials found in nature in order to make art. We will study patterns and colors found in nature and learn about the properties of different natural materials. We will spend time outside, gathering materials and getting inspiration from nature. Some activities will include nature suncatchers, leaf rubbings, mosaics, pine cone mobiles, and so much more! (Enrollment Cap of 20)

Grades 4-8: Let's Play Cards- Spoons. Hearts. Crazy Eights. Cribbage. These aren't random words, they're just some games you can play with a deck of cards. Learn and play fun card games like these people have been playing for generations. (Enrollment Cap of 16)

Grades 4-12: Star Wars Experience - The many worlds of Star Wars will come alive in this researched based class that includes the history of Star Wars, the study of planets and species, and Star Wars themed crafts.(Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 4-12: The Magical World of Harry Potter- "You're a wizard Harry!" And you can be a wizard too! Come experience the magical world of Harry Potter as we read sections from the books, learn to play quidditch and wizard's chess, and create other magical objects like wands and butter beer. (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 5-8: MinecraftEdu- Come work as a team and play in the sandbox world of Minecraft! Create Minecraft models of famous buildings or moments in history. Use Minecraft to learn about science. (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 5-8: Advanced Spanish - Do you know some Spanish, but would really like to learn more? Are you in a Spanish class and would like to master more of the language? Do you plan on visiting Spain or Mexico? If you answered yes, then check out Advanced Spanish. This class is for students who know or have some background knowledge in the Spanish language and are interested in learning more. Students will continue to build upon their Spanish skills and fluency by being actively engaged in the language. Spanish will be taught in a fun and exciting way through music, food, skits, games, projects, and crafts. Hope to see you there! ¡Espero verte allí! (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 5-8: Volleyball- Calling all players that love volleyball! Come join us to learn the basics of volleyball including the forearm pass, overhead pass, serving and hitting. We will cover the rules according to WIAA. Team offense and defense will also be taught. Students will develop their skills on an individual, small group and team basis while playing fun lead up games and team challenges. (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 5-12: Helping Hands- Let's give our town a helping hand. This class is looking for positive students who want to help out, such as volunteer at a senior center, learn babysitting skills, clean up an area, and more. (No enrollment cap)

Grades 6-8: Reading Rocks! - This class has been designed for students who want to read a variety of interesting books while getting some extra practice reading, writing, and thinking at the middle school level. (No enrollment cap)

Grades 6-8: CMS Summer Band Camp - Percussion - CMS Summer Band Camp is not only a great opportunity to improve on your instrument, but also to have fun playing with other people over the summer! Students will be separated into classes by like instrument (brass, woodwind, and percussion) and will cover playing fundamentals while learning new music. Come join us for some awesome summer band fun! This period is for students in percussion section only. (Enrollment cap of 25)

Grades 6-8: CodeDotOrg - Learn the highly desirable task of coding through code.org's self-paced courses. You could be a newb or a basic coder and there will be a course for you! (Enrollment Cap of 16)

Grades 7-12: Dead of Winter- Think you have what it takes to survive the Zombie Apocalypse? Here's your chance to prove it! Students will create a character to guide through the post zombie disaster dystopian, work together to found, run, and protect a colony, and most of all find a way to survive the end of the world! Do you strive for teamwork and harmony in order to live? Or do you go the lone wolf route and take your chances? Mother Nature herself might have a say as the outbreak happened at the worst time - the dead of winter. Due to the situations presented in the class the class will be restricted to upper grade level students. Parents, please be advised of the subject matter when deciding if this class is right for your student. (Enrollment cap of 30)

Grades 7-12: Athletic Performance- Athletic Performance is designed for athletes and students that are interested in gaining greater strength, size, explosive power, speed, agility, and flexibility. This is done through an hour and half class period where 40 minutes are spent in the weight room, 40 minutes in the gym or outside, plus a 5 minute warm-up and cool down. **This class only runs Monday-Thursday and will run until July 19th.** Students taking other summer school sessions will spend the Athletic Performance session in the LMC on Friday's. Students who do not have transportation do not have to continue attending after June 30th, unless they choose. There are four meeting times for this course, students can attend whichever one they choose daily. Two evening sessions are offered- 4:00-5:30 and 5:30-7:00. (No Enrollment Cap)

Period 2 (9:15 – 10:25)

Grades K-2: Storytime Activities Part 2- Only for students who also signed up for Part 1. This class is all about popular children's books! Each day we will be reading a few different books and making a craft or doing a fun activity that goes along with the book theme. Children will also get a chance to act out scenes from the books and even get to dress up like their favorite storybook characters. Some examples may include reading books about a tea party and then having an impromptu tea party in the classroom or reading books about creatures under the sea and then making some of those creatures. (Enrollment cap of 16)

Grades 1-3: Mad Fun Science- Fun hands on experiments will be conducted by our little scientists in the classroom lab. Art projects and cool concepts will be explored! Students will record their observations and predictions in their own science journals. Join us for some scientific adventures that are guaranteed to be explosively fun! (Enrollment cap of 16)

Grades 1-3: Nature Art– This course will involve using materials found in nature in order to make art. We will study patterns and colors found in nature and learn about the properties of different natural materials. We will spend time outside, gathering materials and getting inspiration from nature. Some activities will include nature suncatchers, leaf rubbings, mosaics, pine cone mobiles, and so much more! (Enrollment Cap of 15)

Grades 1-4: Intro to Spanish - This class is for students who are interested in learning Spanish. Students will learn how to have basic conversations and will learn lots of words and phrases in Spanish. Spanish will be taught in a fun and exciting way through music, food, games, projects, and crafts. Hope to see you there! ¡Espero verte allí! (No enrollment cap)

Grades 1-4: Under the Sea - Our oceans are full of beauty and wonder, a separate world waiting for us to explore. We will become ocean explorers this summer and learn about the mysteries of the oceans! We will research different ocean animals through books and videos, and create amazing ocean animal crafts. Through fun filled ocean games, experiments, and arts and crafts we will become experts on our oceans! (Enrollment cap of 20)

Grades 2-5: Board Game Bonanza- Play fun board games that will keep your mind sharp over the summer! Checkers, Connect 4, Monopoly Jr., Scrabble Jr. and many more games will be taught and played in this summer school class. (Enrollment Cap of 15)

Grades 3-5: Chickens in the Classroom- Yup, you heard right, we will have baby chicks in our classroom! Students will get to witness the incubation, hatching, and growing of chickens. Throughout the course students will learn about different breeds of chickens. Students will calculate the feed and water consumption of the chickens as well as the hatch rates of different breeds. If you love baby chicks this is the class for you! (Enrollment cap of 20)

Grades 3-6 Learning More with Legos- This class is for older students looking for more challenging Lego projects, games, and puzzles. Please do not register the same student for both Lego classes as some of the projects will be similar but tailored for the age group. (Enrollment cap of 20)

Grades 3-8: I Survived - Learn basic camping and survival skills in this camping-themed class. Learn traditional survival and camping skills as well as engage in indoor and outdoor hands-on activities. Have a "camp-out" together to apply what you've learned. (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 4-5: Reading Rocks! - This class has been designed for students who want to read a variety of interesting books while getting some extra practice reading, writing, and thinking at the upper elementary school level. (No enrollment cap)

Grades 4-6: Let's Get Craftier -Do you like to make crafts? Or do you want to learn how to make crafts? Well, this is the class for you! In Let's Get Crafty, you will use your imagination and creative skills to make homemade crafts. Some crafts are BIG! Some crafts are small! Some crafts will be painted! Some crafts will be made from recyclables! If you're looking to spend your summer being active and artistic, then Let's Get Craftier is the class for you! This class will have more advanced crafts than the class that is meant for 2nd to 4th graders! (Enrollment cap of 14 students)

Grades 4-12: Crochet Corner - Calling all crafty crocheters! Students will have the opportunity to create hats, flowers, slippers, handbags, and more! The sky's the limit with Crochet Corner! Whether you're new to crochet or have already made some amazing items, this class is for you! (Enrollment cap of 12 students)

Grades 5-6: Conversational Mandarin Chinese for Beginners – Ni hau! Jen da? Shen ma? Hello. Really? What? YES!, A chance to learn simple, basic Mandarin phrases and write characters and learn a little Chinese culture! Come hang out and Shwo some Jung Wen! Come has some fun with Mrs. Lund! Grades 5-8: Intro to Digital Photography - This course will cover the basics of digital photography. The first week we will introduce the basic principles of photography, including composition and lighting. The next two weeks will be divided up to include close-up photography, portrait photography, action photography, and landscape photography. We will be taking and evaluating many photographs throughout this course, as well as researching and looking at the works of professional photographers. It's preferred that students bring their own digital cameras so they can learn how to get the most out of them. (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 5-8: Volleyball- Calling all players that love volleyball! Come join us to learn the basics of volleyball including the forearm pass, overhead pass, serving and hitting. We will cover the rules according to WIAA. Team offense and defense will also be taught. Students will develop their skills on an individual, small group and team basis while playing fun lead up games and team challenges. (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 6-8: CMS Summer Band Camp - Woodwinds - CMS Summer Band Camp is not only a great opportunity to improve on your instrument, but also to have fun playing with other people over the summer! Grades 1-4: Youth Fitness - The objective of this class is to improve students overall fitness levels through many different activities including games, fitness stations, and climbing wall activities. (Enrollment cap of 24)

Grades 2-3: Reading Rocks! - This class has been designed for students who want to read a variety of interesting books while getting some extra practice reading, writing, and thinking at the mid-elementary level. (No enrollment cap)

Grades 3-6: Intro to Spanish - Do you know some Spanish, but would really like to learn more? Are you an older student looking to try Spanish? This class is for students who know or have some background knowledge in the Spanish language and are interested in learning more or for older students looking to learn! Students will continue to build upon their Spanish skills in speaking, listening, reading, and writing by being actively engaged in the language. Students will learn lots of vocabulary and grammar. Spanish will be taught in a fun and exciting way through music, food, skits, games, projects, and crafts. Hope to see you there! ¡Espero verte allí! (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 3-8: Pets 101- Are you an animal lover? Then this is the class for you! Come join Mrs. Pape as we learn all about animals. We will learn about how to train and care for animals, be responsible pet guardians, and make our community a safer place for all animals. And of course, the class wouldn't be complete without some fun! We will have visits from some of our local furry friends and create some gifts that you get to take home to your pets! (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 4-7: SHHH! (We're Reading)– Do you LOVE to read! Do you wish you had time during the day to read what YOU want to? Then sign up for SHHH! (We're Reading!), the class where you will have time to just read. You will be able to share what you love (or hate) about the book you're currently reading. We will visit the LMC often, so you can get new books to read or check out books that your group mates have told you about. Then, SHHH! It's time to read! (Enrollment Cap of 18)

Grades 4-12: Star Wars Experience - The many worlds of Star Wars will come alive in this researched based class that includes the history of Star Wars, the study of planets and species, and Star Wars themed crafts.(Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 4-12: The Magical World of Harry Potter- “You’re a wizard Harry!” And you can be a wizard too! Come experience the magical world of Harry Potter as we read sections from the books, learn to play quidditch and wizard’s chess, and create other magical objects like wands and butter beer. (Enrollment cap of 15)

Grades 5-8: Volleyball- Calling all players that love volleyball! Come join us to learn the basics of volleyball including the forearm pass, overhead pass, serving and hitting. We will cover the rules according to WIAA. Team offense and defense will also be taught. Students will be separated into classes by like instrument (brass, woodwind, and percussion) and will cover playing fundamentals while learning new music. Come join us for some awesome summer band fun! This period is for students who are in the brass section only. (Enrollment cap of 25)**Grades**

Grades 6-9: Around the World in 14 Days - Grab your passports, pack your bags, and get ready to explore the world! While traveling the world students will create a variety of cultural crafts, learn some new languages, and play games from different countries. We will travel to a new country each day. There are so many fascinating and creative things to learn about the different cultures around us. Bon Voyage! (Enrollment cap of 20)

Grades 6-12: Cooking Around the World – In this course, students will learn essential cooking skills and master the fundamentals of cooking. All while learning to cook cuisine from Around the World! We will make dishes from China, Italy, Mexico, Germany and more. And best of all you will get to try all of your cooking! (Enrollment Cap of 16)

Grades 6-12: Sports and Journalism - Be a better sports fan while understanding what it's like to be on the sports beat. We're looking for future BDN'ers, ESPN'ers, or just anyone who is interested. Students will learn about sports journalism in print, radio, and television. Students will also learn get new insights into their favorite sports. (Enrollment cap of 30)

This is done through an hour and half class period where 40 minutes are spent in the weight room, 40 minutes in the gym or outside, plus a 5 minute warm-up and cool down. **This class only runs Monday-Thursday and will run until July 19th.** Students taking other summer school sessions will spend the Athletic Performance session in the LMC on Friday's. Students who do not have transportation do not have to continue attending after June 30th, unless they choose. There are four meeting times for this course, students can attend whichever one they choose daily. Two evening sessions are offered- 4:00-5:30 and 5:30-7:00. (No Enrollment Cap)

Grade 5K: The ABC and 123 of Kindergarten! - Students will tame any fear of entering 5K through fun interactive readiness activities including math, reading, music, stories, and centers. (No Enrollment Cap)

Getting Ready For Grade Level Classes (NEW) -

This year, we split these classes into three separate parts so that parents and students could pick the subjects that fit their interests or needs. Please look on Page 3 to find which period is Math/STEM, Reading/Writing, and then Paw Pride Activities/Projects.

Grade 1: 1st Grade, Here I Come- This course will give students the opportunity to familiarize themselves with the first grade in a fun yet educational way. Class lessons will integrate specific strategies that will promote reading readiness. Students will have opportunities to explore, examine and make mathematical connections as they investigate math concepts.
